

Did You Know?

When the following 7 criteria are met, the opportunity for more organs being suitable for transplant increases dramatically*.

- Sodium <155
- Mean Arterial Pressure >60
- 1 or fewer Pressors, (excludes Vasopressin)
- pH 7.35 - 7.45
- CVP <10 or
- PCWP 8 - 12
- PO₂ >300 or 3:1 ratio for O₂ challenge
- Urine 1 - 2 ml/kg/hr

* applies to solid organ donation, does not apply to tissue or eye donation.

JCAHO supports goals of:

75% conversion rate

This is the number of actual organ donors divided by the number of eligible donors

100% referral rate

This is the percent of patients that were referred to IOPO that met a clinical trigger for organ donation

One organ donor can save 8 lives.
