Conversion Rate-number of eligible donors over actual donors-expressed as a percentage.* JC requirement for organ conversion rate is 75%.

Referral Rate-Number of patients who meet criteria to be referred for organ donation over actual patients referred.* JC goal for referral rate is 100%.

Clinical Triggers for Organ Donation:

Call when your patient meets one of these triggers:

- Vented patients with a GCS of 5 or less
- Before any withdraw of life support. Call at first mention from family or physician

One organ donor can save 8 lives.
