What is a shared medical record?

Your medical, family, and social history, including lab and procedure results, medications, and allergies stored in a secure electronic medical record. This information will be available to authorized providers participating in your care within the Community Health Network.

Who has access to your medical record?

All Community Health Network providers who participate in your care will soon have access to your medical record information. As per our notice of privacy practices, "Since we are an integrated system, we may share your PHI (protected health information) with designated staff within the Community Health Network, for treatment, payment or operations purposes."

How does a shared medical record benefit you as a patient?

All authorized providers within the network will be working from the same information, leading to efficient care coordination & reducing potential for error or repeat tests. Soon you will be able to fill out only one set of forms to list your medical history and registration, saving you time in relaying information.
