Sleep Apnea/OSA	CPAP Adjustment	Can only be done if patient had a prior Sleep Study. If the Sleep Study was done elsewhere, we must have a copy of their original Sleep Study faxed to us prior to testing. If none is available, a Split Study should be scheduled.
Sleep Apnea/OSA	BIPAP Adjustment	Can only be done if patient had a prior Sleep Study. If the Sleep Study was done elsewhere, we must have a copy of their original Sleep Study faxed to us prior to testing. If none is available, a Split Study should be scheduled.

Follow-Up Daytime for: Sleep Apnea Continuous Agonizing Drowsiness Narcolepsy	MSLT Only	This can be scheduled only if they have had a prior OPSG. If the OPSG was done elsewhere, we will need of copy of it faxed to us prior to testing. If an OPSG was never done, an OPSG/MSLT should be scheduled.
MWT for: Sleep Apnea Continuous Agonizing Drowsiness	Maintenance of Wakefulness Test	This test is scheduled in an MSLT Spot. Patients are to check in at 8 AM.
Daytime OPSG for Nightshifters: Sleep Apnea Continuous Agonizing Drowsiness	OPSG Only	Daytime OPSGs scheduled for Nightshifters are scheduled in an MSLT Spot. Patients are to check in at 6:30 AM. An MSLT will not be done.
Sleep Studies for Children: Sleep Apnea Continuous Agonizing Drowsiness Narcolepsy	OPSG Only -> OPSG/MSLT ->	Children ages 2 - 5 years old. Children 6 years and above. The North Pediatric facility tests children 2 - 14 years old. The Carmel facility can only test children ages 7 and above.

OPSG = Overnight Polysomnogram
MSLT = Multiple Sleep Latency Test
CPAP = Continuous Positive Airway Pressure
