

Community Heart and Vascular Hospital Unit Descriptions

UNIT	NUMBER OF BEDS	DESCRIPTION
<u>SICU/PACU</u>	8 beds with a PACU of 8 beds in a combined area.	Located on the first floor; Types of patients are post-op CABG, Valve repair and replacement, AAA, post-op PVD, carotid endarterectomy. Current initiative is surgical wound and diabetes care. LVAD's Shifts are 8, 10 and 12-hours.
<u>MICU</u>	8 Bed	Located on the second floor; 2 patients per 1 RN. Patients include medical cardiac ICU, critically ill cardiac and peripheral vascular patients (ventilators, hemodynamic monitoring, IABP, Hypothermia protocol, LVAD's).
<u>2 TH/PCU</u>	16 Beds	Located on the second floor; 4-6 patients per day. Patients include post op open heart surgery, vascular surgery (fem pop, AAA repairs, CEA, other) medical cardiac, CHF arrhythmias, chest pain, unstable angina and syncope. Current initiatives include diabetes care, surgical wound care and patient safety. Shifts are 8, 10, and 12-hour.
<u>3 TH/PCU</u>	24 Beds	Located on the third floor; 4 patients per day. Patients include cardiac medical, Heart Failure, arrhythmias, MI, chest pain, unstable angina, syncope, peripheral vascular intervention, carotid stenting. Current initiatives include Heart Failure management, diabetes care, surgical wound care and patient safety. Shifts are 8, 10 and 12-hour.
<u>Operating Room (OR)</u>	4 suite OR	Located on the first floor; suites are fully digital. Cardiac, peripheral vascular and thoracic surgical procedures are the routine. Surgeries are Open Heart, Lead Placement, Carotid Endarterectomy, AAA Repairs (both open and endograft), and Peripheral Vascular surgeries. LVAD placement. Hybrid surgeries. Shifts are 10 hours
<u>Emergency Department</u>	8 Bed 2 Bay Shock Room	Focusing on cardiology. Only cardiac ED in Indiana with a Cardiologist in house 24 hours a day. ED is directly adjacent to cath labs. All ED beds have cardiac monitoring. Average of 10 patients per day. Immediate triage at the bedside, point of care lab with cardiac marker results in 15 minutes. Shifts are 8, 10 and 12-hour.
<u>Cath Lab</u>		Average 15-25 patients per day. Patients include diagnostic and interventional cardiac, vascular and electrophysiology patients.
<u>Day Bed</u>	32 Beds	For outpatient pre-op, teaching, recovery and observation.

		Average of 25 patients per day. Patients include pre-op cardiac and vascular surgery, elective cardioversion, pre-op clinic, ED overflow, IP overflow, pre and post PV angiogram and Cardiac Cath and interventions. Shifts are 8, 10, and 12-hours.
<u>Healthy Hearts Center</u>		Hours are 7:00am to 5:30pm, Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays. 10-12 patients per day. Patients include diagnosed CHF, NYHC, II, III, IV, and infusion therapy.
