

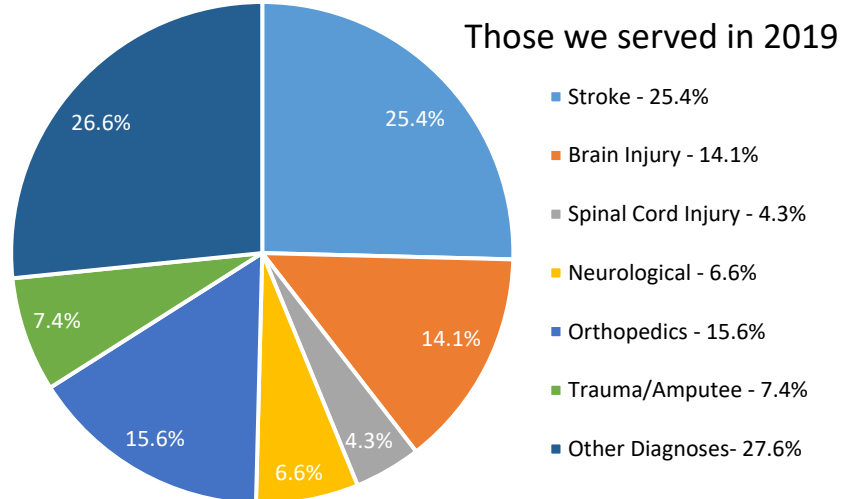

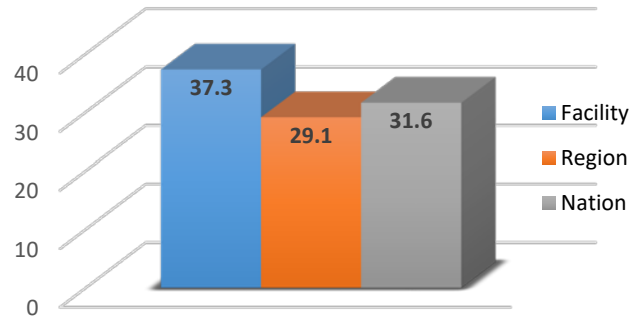
Acute Rehabilitation Program

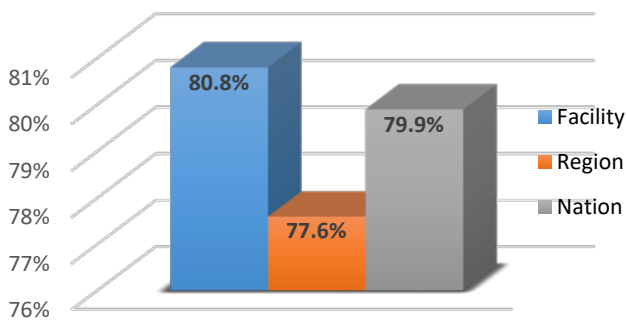


Functional Independence Measure (FIM®)* Gain – Admission to Discharge

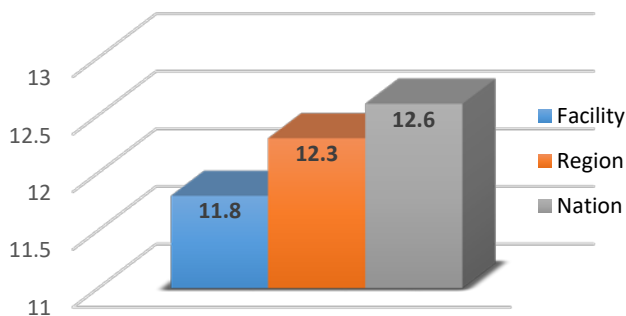


*FIM-Functional Independence Measurements – a measure of a patient's functional level consisting of 13 Motor and 5 Cognitive Measures. FIM is scored on a 0-7 scale with 7 being total independent, 1 being total assistance/dependent, and 0 being unable to test.
