ICU	2 West	12	All private rooms are capable of performing continuous EKG, Hemodynamic, BIS, ICP monitoring and ventilator support.
PCU	2 South	24	All private rooms are capable of performing continuous EKG and hemodynamic monitoring and ventilator support
Ortho/Neuro/Spine Unit	3 South	21	Common joint replacement surgeries, with remote telemetry available if needed, may include hip, knee, shoulder or other orthopedic procedures requiring inpatient post-operative stay. Patient's diagnosis may include ORIF, bone/joint repair or reconstruction, treatment and aggressive management of patients with degenerative disc disease and post-operative recovery from neuro and spine surgery. Within the ONS unit, is a program offered for the elective total joint patients, providing post-operative care and rapid initial rehabilitation from replacements. This program is referred to as Center for Joint Health and is a collaborative effort of multiple disciplines. This is a designated Stroke Neuro unit allowing RNs certified on the NIH Stroke Scale provide specific care to the recovering stroke patient.
HEM/ONC PCU	4 South	12	The primary scope of this unit facilitates patient's that have various concerns related to hematology or oncology diagnosis. Patients may be receiving treatments r/t complications, administration of chemotherapy or end of life care.
Surgical Unit	5 South	24	The primary scope of this unit facilitates patient's recovery process for the general surgical patient, with remote telemetry available if needed. Preoperative care is provided with collaboration of the OR Department. Surgical procedures include general abdominal surgeries, colon resections, urological procedures, hysterectomies, plastics, TRAM patients, thyroidectomies, gastric by-pass, and post-operative cases with the use of the DaVinci. The unit has obtained Bariatric Certification.

Medical Unit	3 West/3 West	36	The primary scope of this medical/telemetry unit is to provide care of the chronic and acute diseases of the heart, lung, endocrine, oncology, and GI or GU. Inpatient hospice and palliative care is also provided. The medical unit incorporates the use of transitional care nurses who assist patients with chronic diseases especially the heart failure and COPD patients to achieve life goals and greater quality of life. Additional programs available are End of Life care and Life's Journey. RN certification on the NIH Stroke Scale provides specific
			care to the recovering stroke patient. Inpatient VEEG (video electroencephalogram) monitoring is available in room 3303.
Pediatrics	4 South	4	The unit provides monitoring for children with cardiac/apnea monitors, noninvasive blood pressure monitoring and oxygen saturation monitors.
Short Stay	First Floor	20	Patient diagnosis includes: same day surgery or procedural recovery (laparoscopic and endoscope procedures; tissue biopsies; biliary drain placements; placement of chest ports and permacaths; kyphoplasties; IVC filter placement; paracentesis, chemotherapy; infusion therapy; observation; radiation therapy, recovery from endoscope procedures.
Maternity Rooms	4 West 4 East	14 6	Maternity Services is located on the 4 th floor and consists of 14 private LDRP suites in addition to one semi-private room. Four patient triage rooms and two operating rooms/delivery rooms are located with in the unit.
Level II NICU		10	The Level II NICU has 10 beds and an isolation room.
Emergency Room	First Floor		The Emergency Department serves approximately 50,000 patients annually. The Department will provide acute care services to all patients presenting for treatment within our capabilities. Patient's requiring services outside our capabilities will receive diagnostic and stabilizing treatment followed by a transfer to an appropriate facility.
